INFORMATION and RAIN DAY RULES

BEETHOVEN IN THE PARK - Concerts of the Hungarian National Philharmonic in Martonvásár 2021

We wish to inform you that, in accordance with the current regulations and until further notice, tickets sales to the event allow entry only for immunity cardholders and for children under the age of 18 accompanied by an adult in possession of an immunity card. Cards will be checked upon entry.

In the interests of the safety of the spectators and performers, please take your seat in the audience in the order of your arrival, maintaining a safe social distance.

Concert goers with a valid ticket for the **Beethoven in the Park** (Beethoven concerts in Martonvásár) concert series can enter the park of the MTA Centre for Agricultural Research without charge **after 6 pm on the day of the concert**.

The organisers will check the validity of the concert tickets at the entrance to the park and at the bridge leading to the concert venue.

In the event of adverse weather, we will provide notice of cancellation by 2 pm on the day of the concert at the latest. If no announcement is made, then we are still expecting the event to take place. In the event of technical issues caused by adverse weather, we will wait a maximum of one hour from the scheduled start time to begin the concert. In the event of rain, the management of the National Philharmonic Orchestra may also make a decision regarding the cancellation of the concert at the venue itself.

If the concert is postponed, the tickets are automatically valid for the designated rain date. You can check the day of the rain date on our website, **www.filharmonikusok.hu**, or on the ticket itself.

If the concert has a designated rain date, and the concert takes place on that day, we are not able to provide a refund for the ticket. If adverse weather causes the concert to be brought to a close early, the concert is considered to have taken place.

If the postponed concert does not take place on the rain date either due to adverse weather conditions, it will not be possible to provide a refund for the ticket on the day of the cancelled concert itself. Tickets for any cancelled concert can be refunded on the first working day following the cancelled concert date until 1 September at the National Philharmonic Orchestra External Box Office (1075 Budapest, Károly krt. 21.), during opening hours. In the event of a cancelled performance, tickets purchased on the internet are refunded automatically.

We can only refund tickets if it is not possible to hold the concert on the designated rain date. Any postponed concert will only be rescheduled for a rain date on one occasion.
